Main duties:

Lakeside Corby is one of the biggest GP practices in the UK with over 47000 registered patients and 23 GPs. The practice has a long history of involvement in medical education and as a post-graduate training practice, has a good track record of retaining registrars to work within the organisation. Lakeside has provided placements for Foundation Year doctors for over 4 years. The practice also has strong links with Leicester and Cambridge Medical Schools and is providing placements for up to 24 medical students at any one time. Academic Fellows based at Corby would have ample opportunity to get involved in developing and delivering new teaching to medical and nursing students. We would also be keen to involve fellows in our emerging educational research projects and support them in producing posters and presentations for conferences. For Academic Fellows with an interest in developing understanding in leadership, there is the opportunity to get involved in a number of practice development projects. Lakeside has a well-developed management structure. Members of the executive committee have held leading roles in local and national health organisations and would be very happy to share their experience and knowledge. The Foundation Academic F2 post will be based on medical education and leadership, supervised by Dr Andy Ward who is a partner and Education lead at Lakeside and works at the University of Leicester Medical School. Funding to complete a PG cert in leadership will be available from the Foundation School for the F2 Leadership and Medical Education Post.

F2 Academic posts will include one day per week of clinical contact at Lakeside to ensure that our F2 fellows integrate into practice and develop an insight into the management of a large and complex GP provider. This four month post is based at Lakeside under Dr Ward's supervision but postholders may also be able to liaise with the University of Leicester Medical School. There is no out of hours commitment. The post is tied to clinical posts at Northampton General Hospital for 8 months (2 x 4 months) to allow satisfactory completion of the required Foundation competencies in F2.
