Based in Deene C ward, this is a busy 29 bedded ward. There is a high turnover of new admissions. The most common are Acute General Medical, Gastrointestinal and Liver patients. There is also a good range of other cases. As an F1 Trainee, the role is to support the Medical and Nursing team in diagnosing and treating illnesses; this starts with daily Consultant led ward rounds. The remainder of your day involves completing care plans agreed on the ward round, including blood tests, investigation requests, specialty referrals and patient reviews. Given the high turnover of patients, the wards can be extremely busy and so a good proportion of the day is devoted to planning discharge, including medication requests and discharge paperwork. There is a handover meeting in the morning where you will link in with the ward nursing and therapy staff, planning the workload for the day ahead and again towards the end of the working day. You will supported by a team of 7 consultants, 4 specialist registrars and 4 SHO graduate trainees. In addition, the Trust is in the process of recruiting Physician Associates to help support the ward and clinical teams.

The clinical supervisor for this post is Dr Ajay Verma.

In addition, there is a dedicated on call cardiology service and Kettering is the Primary PCI centre for the county. We also have a dedicated GI bleed rota delivered by our consultant gastroenterologists out of hours.
