## Main duties:

The F1 will be based on Rowan 2 ward at Highbury Hospital. This is an acute admissions ward for women of working age. The number of patients varies between 12 and 20. The F1 will work with 2 other trainees (GPVTS and CT in psychiatry). The F1 will also work closely with the multidisciplinary ward team, and liaise with other teams and agencies where appropriate. All work will be closely supervised by consultants and other more senior staff. Dr Ruth Shaw will be the clinical supervisor for this post. Dr Asad Malik will cover this supervision when Dr Shaw is away. Duties will include clerking in of new patients, under supervision. Also attending to daily needs of ward patients for their physical and mental health. The F1 will also attend the weekly MDT and will take it in turns with other junior doctors to attend the weekly ward reviews (of which there are 4). The F1 will also participate in on call work at weekends, but not overnight. This on call work will be supervised by the duty doctor and other more senior staff as appropriate.

## Educational Activities:

Weekly F2 teaching sessions on Tuesdays. Weekly Journal club/case conference (JCCC) at Highbury Hospital followed by Balint groups on Weds mornings. The F1 will receive 1 hour's supervision per week from Dr Shaw to discuss educational objectives, clinical topics, work place based assessments etc. There will be opportunity for the F1 to attend "taster" sessions in other clinical areas (eg. out-patients, crisis team) as an observer, according to interests and agreed with clinical supervisor. There will be opportunity to participate in audit where appropriate.
