Job Description

Community placement in CAMHS in a mixed urban and rural setting as well as adult inpatient psychiatry unit in PHC.

CAMHS, Lincolnshire Partnership Foundation NHS Trust – Lincoln Hub

The FT2 post is based at the Horizon Centre, Monson Street, Lincoln LN5 7RZ.

Placement

The F2 doctor will be working in a community Child and Adolescent Mental Health Tier 3 (Specialist) Team in the West Lindsey CAMHS catchment area of Lincolnshire, which includes the western fringe of Lincoln and population centres of Gainsborough, Market Rasen, and Caistor.

The CAMHS team takes a holistic view of children's psychological well-being and mental health and assessments include all aspects of the child and young person's life.

Along with personal supervision, the F2 doctor will also be exposed to multi-disciplinary case discussions during the team's weekly group supervision and consultation forum to which the F2 doctor will be encouraged to contribute.

Assessment templates will be available for the F2 doctor to contribute to the comprehensive assessment, some of which will be community based.

CAMHS also has a monthly academic forum where all doctors within CAMHS are supported to undertake all levels of audits and research with objective of presenting at a local, regional or national level including posters. The CAMHS medical staff have a good track record of publications arising from some of these research projects. The local CAMHS Service consists of 2 consultant child psychiatrists each with their own catchment area, who share a multi-professional team, including psychologists, nurse specialists, and staff from social work background but employed in generic/specialist CAMHS posts. Other medical staff also include a Specialist Trainee and a Core Trainee.

The F2 doctor will attend joint specialist out patient clinics where children with a wide variety of problems are seen. The F2 can contribute to both the physical assessment where necessary, as well as a mental health assessment

Dr Nadkarni is regularly involved in audits of NICE guidelines, which the F2 doctor would be encouraged to help to plan and conduct.

The F2 doctor would also have the opportunity to attend, and if appropriate present, at the weekly postgraduate programme during term time, which typically includes a Case Presentation, Presenting the Evidence (Journal Club) and a presentation by an external speaker.

The CAMHS team has its own academic programme where the F2 will also be encouraged to present a case or interesting and relevant articles from the peer reviewed journals.

The other half of the post is based in the acute adult inpatient psychiatric unit based at the Peter Hodgkinson Centre in Lincoln. This post provides two days per week experience in acute general adult in-patient psychiatry, working on a busy 22 bedded general adult acute in-patient ward.
