- i. 'When evaluated' is indicative, but may be carried out at any time throughout the selection process
- ii. Time of appointment refers to the date at which the post commences. Please note, Medically qualified applicants must be registered with the GDC but be eligible for registration with the GMC.
- iii. Can be used as shortlisting criterion
- iv. The Support for Application to another region form, signed by the Training Programme Director of their current Specialty Training Programme confirming satisfactory progress must be submitted to the recruitment office at time of application.
- v. Applications will only be considered if applicants provide a Support for Reapplication to a Specialty Training Programme form, signed by both the Training Programme Director/Head of School and the Postgraduate Dean in the Local Office/Deanery that the training took place.

 Extraordinary circumstances may be defined as a demonstrated change in circumstances, which can be shown on the ability to train at that time and may include severe personal illness or family caring responsibility incompatible with continuing to train. Completed forms must be submitted at the time of application. No other evidence will be accepted.

- vii. Applicants with BDS alone or with MB BS (or a recognized equivalent medical qualification) must be able to demonstrate a sound understanding of the importance of medicine to the practice of Oral Medicine through the application form and during the interview and selection process.
