Main duties:					
<p>The 12-month post is divided into 3 blocks. There are two clinical posts: one based at the Kettering General Hospital with the Respiratory/GIM team which includes acute medicine on-call and another based at a community practice (Lakeside Surgery). These are dedicated posts that provide the post-holder with a broad training in acute and chronic medicine. The post-holder will have a 4-month dedicated period of research. The F2 will be responsible with the Registrar for the management of patients admitted to the Medical wards. He/she will supervise the F1, be expected to attend Consultant ward rounds and ward rounds with their medical teams. The F2 will work a full shift in the Admission Assessment Unit whilst on call. The Registrar is responsible for the medical management of each firm.</p> <p>During the research/academics post, the F2 will work with their supervisor/s at KGH and Leicester to develop/participate in a research project, perform a literature search, participate in data collection and data entry, perform initial analyses, and work towards writing up the project. They are expected to attend the research meetings at KGH and Leicester.</p>
