| <p>As an FY1 you do the ward based jobs on a normal 8.00am-5.00pm day. There are on-call commitments where from 8.00am-5.00pm you do your normal commitments for the day as well as some on-call jobs working with the nurse practitioner. From 5.00-8.30pm it is on call commitments. You may be asked to assist in theatre as part of your on call commitment, but gain a lot of procedural techniques and competencies on the ward setting. During your on call you will be expected to cover the urology patients, including those who are already inpatients, and admit acute urological emergency patients. There will be daily senior ward rounds to help support you in your daily activities, helping plan investigations and treatments as well as help in preparing for discharge.
