<b>Main duties:</b>					
<p>This F1 post is primarily ward based caring for patients admitted with emergency general surgical problems or elective patients with gastrointestinal problems. You will be responsible for ensuring patients are optimised peri-operatively working with the support of a consultant, specialist registrar and SHO grade trainee. You will have opportunities to attend theatre sessions usually when on call but gain a lot of procedural techniques and competencies on the ward setting. There will be daily senior ward rounds to help support you in your daily activities, helping plan investigations and treatments as well as help in preparing for discharge. The on call rota attracts a 40% banding. You will also cover the surgical wards (Deene A &amp; B) looking after general surgical and urology patients.</p> <p>The clinical supervisor for this post is Mr M Rashed.</p>
