The Academic Medicine post may be hosted by any academic department within the University, including, but not limited to, Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics and Genetics. During the 4 month post individuals will complete a research project in a subject/area of their own choosing, working with a research active investigator with suitable experience and infrastructure to support you and your research project. There is no on call component to the Academic Medicine Placement</p>
