9.	Description of training post	<p>DCTs in the community attend consultant new patient and treatment clinics in special care dentistry. Clinical experience is gained in treatments under local anaesthetic, inhalation sedation and intravenous sedation. There are opportunities to attend general anaesthetic and domiciliary treatment sessions. You will provide care for patients with complex disabilities (learning, medical, physical, mental health) under direct supervision. Sessions will be mainly community based but you will be at the dental hospital.</p> <p>You will have a weekly sedation clinic providing care for phobic adults under inhalation and intravenous sedation. This will provide an opportunity to gain accreditation in this area. You will be involved in undergraduate supervision, working directly under a clinical supervisor on a weekly basis.</p> <p>No on-call commitment.</p> <p>All DCTs also gain experience in managing patients with complex medical histories.
