All DCTs in Restorative Dentistry attend consultant led new patient clinics and multidisciplinary clinics. They undertake a wide range of restorative treatments including periodonta treatment, endodontic, fixed and removable prosthodontics conservative dentistry, and prevention. At DCT3 level there is some timetable variation between posts but all include new patient clinics and treatment sessions and some multidisciplinary clinics including Oncology and Cleft clinics.
