The team comprises of 2 OMFS Consultants, 1 OMFS registrar and 4 Specialty Doctor Grade Clinicians.</p> <p>There is a full range of OMFS treatment carried out by the department however major cancer surgery is carried out at the nearby Sheffield Teaching Hospitals. There are several GA lists each week where the DCT has the opportunity to further develop clinically under close supervision and support. There are several MOS clinics, soft tissue lists and IV sedation clinics each week where the DCT will have the opportunity to develop further under close supervision. It is hoped that the DCT will develop a level of competence through mentorship with reference to the delivery of IV sedation.</p> <p>Other duties for the DCT involve supporting regular out-patient clinics and emergency clinics. A bleep service exists (8am-5pm)</p>

There are 2 Educational Supervisors who both work on a part-time basis so there is an ES present each working day. Previous DCTs have experienced a lot of hands-on surgical experience and had the opportunity to effectively develop both clinically and professionally throughout the year. The position is day-time duties only with no evening / weekend cover requirements.
