		are several MOS clinics, soft tissue lists and IV sedation clinics		
		each week where the DCT will have the opportunity to develop		
		further under close supervision. It is hoped that the DCT will		
		develop a level of competence through mentorship with		
		reference to the delivery of IV sedation.		
		Other duties for the DCT involve supporting regular out-patient		
		clinics and emergency clinics. A bleep service exists (8am-5pm)
