Accessing Providers

Salisbury will then provide the Provider(s)' Bid Response and the Employer can then Direct Award using Salisbury's Unique Reference Number form available on request, or can conduct a further competition between their regional or the national providers using local criteria, carried out on their behalf by Salisbury's team.

Contracting

Contracts will be under NHS Terms & Conditions, with Provider bid response, commercial response, and Employer/Provider written agreements already inserted. Employers can then complete the Contract Call Off and exchange with their selected provider, with a copy to Salisbury.
