Main duties:					
<p>The post involves working on different areas of acute medicine, ie, admission unit (AMU), acute frailty unit (AFU), short stay unit (SSU) and acute ambulatory clinic (AAC) in rotation. This post gives FY trainees opportunity to learn management of acutely unwell patients under supervision of consultants, registrars, and CMT. There are enough opportunities for SLEs/ self-directed learning/ clinical teaching on ward rounds. There is opportunity to do acute medicine related audits, case reporting and to attend OPD for those who are interested and well organised. There are regular educational activities for the trainees of all grades. Each trainee in the department gets a chance to present to the peers in the departmental meeting.</p>
