

# Managing the Trainee Returning to Training: SuppoRTT Workshop for Educational Supervisors

Returning to work after a period of absence can be a challenging time for both learners and educators. Trainees can feel “rusty” and have reduced confidence that their knowledge and skills are at the level they were prior to absence. They may be absent for several reasons and periods of absence may vary in duration from a few days to several years. For the Educator, trying to piece together these threads and ensure a safe but supported return can be anything but straightforward.

The Supported Return to Training (SuppoRTT) scheme is an initiative designed to enhance the return to work and training experience, to support safe readjustment and maintain high-quality, patient-safe care. A fundamental part of the scheme is the funding for further training of Educational Supervisors so that they feel more supported and consequently better equipped to support trainees.

Health Education England East Midlands has commissioned a *FREE* half-day course for Educational Supervisors to be held at venues around the region. The session will include:

- **AN INTRODUCTION TO SuppoRTT - *why are we discussing return to training and how are these trainees different?***
- **HEE SuppoRTT Guidance - *what do I need to know?***
- **WORKSHOPS, SIMULATIONS & SCENARIOS - *providing practical advice and demonstrations on how best to support trainees in different situations?***

The training will also include a session on **Neurodiversity in Trainees: How to Support the Trainee with Dyslexia** by one of our expert Coaches, Carla O'Brien.
