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		<p>-Fully supported 3 tier on-call</p> <p>The post provides exposure to all subspecialty areas of OMFS including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diagnosis of oral/head and neck cancer including reconstructive surgery. • Surgery for impacted teeth and roots and diseases of the oral cavity. • Salivary gland diseases, disorders and surgery. • Treatment of facial and jaw injuries (hard and soft tissues). • Correction of both congenital and acquired facial and jaw deformities. • Management of facial pain including jaw joint disorders. • Oral medicine. • Surgical treatment of skin lesions of the face, scalp and neck. • Consultation for patients requiring opinion or treatment planning regarding restorative dentistry. • Specialist treatment of immediate post-op and follow up wounds by wound care specialist. • Oral rehabilitation using self or implant retained prosthetics. <p>Both sites have CBCT and support from advanced laboratories with 3D planning and printing facilities.</p> <p>Research, audit and quality improvement projects are encouraged and supported within our department.</p>

The early shift runs from 07.45am to 5.30pm and the late shift is from 5pm to midnight. Rest days are allocated after on-call and weekend working.</p> <p>There are no overnight on-call commitments as these are kindly covered by our ENT colleagues.</p> <p>The on-call shift is based on site at Northampton, with a 3-tier on call service to support (second on call Registrar/Middle Grade and 3rd on call Consultant who will be based off-site during non-core hours).</p>
