Educational Activities:

- The post is based within the Critical Care Department in normal working hours.
- Out of hours work occurs within the Medical Directorate, largely based on EMU.

- This includes daily reviews, microbiology and Pharmacy ward rounds each day and may offer opportunities to review referrals and discharges with a Consultant or Registrar.
- Training and experience is gained in practical procedures.
- The remainder of the placement is theatre based under direct supervision of an anaesthetist at all times.
- Additional learning opportunities are available in pre-assessment and acute/chronic pain.
- There are excellent opportunities to complete an audit during the placement.
