| <p>This post offers training and experience in acute and general medicine and is based on the Emergency Assessment Unit (EAU). Main duties include managing acute admissions, ward rounds on EAU, doing simple procedures, being on-call for acute medicine, organizing and chasing investigations and results, preparing discharge summaries, assessing National Early Warning Scores (NEWS) and dealing with the sick patient, safety issues and audit opportunities and prioritizing work in a busy environment. The EAU F2 trainee participates in an on-call rota with 12 other colleagues for daytime/evening duties. There is one week of nights (split across two separate weeks) one week in 13 and during on-call periods the postholder is expected to take either GP or A&E referrals as the first point of contact, providing excellent experience in the assessment of acute medical presentations.</p> | | | | | |
