The trainee spends half of the attachment on the ITU, gaining experience in the management of seriously ill patients under close supervision at all times. Trainees will undertake daily reviews including microbiology and Pharmacy ward rounds. There will be opportunities to review referrals and discharges with a Consultant or Registrar. Training will be given for a variety of practical procedures. The remainder of the placement is theatre based, at all times under direct supervision of an anaesthetist. Additional learning opportunities are available in pre-assessment and acute/chronic pain clinics. There are excellent opportunities to complete an audit during the placement. There is Departmental teaching each week.
