<p>The prime clinical learning areas and supervision/support are listed:</p> <p><u>Gynaecology Emergency</u> All GP referrals and a substantial walk-in population come through the department (Gynaecology Assessment Unit GAU). o Sessions with a Gynaecology consultant in direct attendance o Initial review of appropriate cases</p> <p><u>Ward Work</u> o Follow through of team admissions and day case assessments and reviews. o In-patient ongoing care responsibilities along with team specialist trainees. o Experience in gynaecology theatre and caesarean sections. o Experience of multidisciplinary team working & discharge continuity with chronic patients. o IT experience – e-discharge, VTE thromboprophylaxis, Acute Kidney Injury scores (AKI), prescribing, requesting investigations and following them through.</p> <p><u>Out-patient Experience</u> o Observation and participation to learn consultation and communication skills. o The exposure to specialty clinics such as ambulatory gynaecology clinics (out-patient hysteroscopy, colposcopy, urodynamics) o Some specialist clinic exposure to emphasise the out-patient based Multidisciplinary team approach (Gynaecological oncology, Urogynaecology)</p>
