<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clerking new medical admissions, organising and reviewing appropriate investigations and starting initial management plans under the supervision of senior doctors.</li> <li>• Arranging appropriate discharge paperwork and follow up for patients discharged from the EMU.</li> <li>• Supervision of the EMU F1 and on call F1, in conjunction with the SpRs and consultants.</li> <li>• Participation in some post take ward rounds (the 2 acute consultants both take part in the on call rota).</li> <li>• Participation in F2 out of hours rota which includes evenings/weekends both on EMU and the general medical wards.</li> </ul>
