Main duties:					
<p>To undertake the induction programmes, as specified by the individual services, within each of the areas covered in this placement, these are Genito Urinary Medicine (GUM), Gynaecology and community Contraception and Sexual Health (CASH) .</p> <p>To work within each clinical area at an F2 level under the supervision of senior doctors.</p> <p>Within GUM and CASH the F2 doctor will, once having completed the basic training given within each specialty, see unselected clinic patients in the clinics within which they are working. This will include a broad spectrum of presentations to GUM and CASH and the F2 doctor will be expected, having interviewed and examined the patient, if required, to formulate a management plan for each patient determining any tests to be taken of treatment/contraception to be offered to the patient. They will have access to Senior support at all times in these clinics. The Thursday evening clinic in GUM runs to 7pm and on Friday morning the F2 will do two CASH clinics, finishing at 2pm.</p> <p>Within Gynaecology the doctor will be assisting with a theatre list, doing out patient clinics and doing half a day (Thursday morning) on call. Clinical Supervision will be provided overall by a Consultant in GU Medicine, within gynaecology the doctor will be supervised by Mr. G. Morgan and within CASH by Dr. W. Morris.</p>

<p>The doctor will be expected to attend their protected learning time teaching each Thursday afternoon and will start the evening GUM clinic late on these days (once the teaching has finished).</p> <p>There should be ample opportunity for the doctor to complete their required SLE's and TAB assessments etc, as required for the F2 programme, and an audit project can be organised during the placement if the F2 doctor wishes to undertake one. There are opportunities for teaching medical students and presenting audits to a multidisciplinary team.</p> <p>The doctor will be expected to become proficient at sexual history taking, sexual health assessments (for infections and contraception) as well as gaining an insight into and knowledge of gynaecologygynaecology.</p>

<p>This is an excellent placement for doctors contemplating careers in many specialties including Community Gyneacology, Genito Urinary Medicine, Contraception and Sexual Health, Gynaecology, General Practice and Dermatology.
