Clinical Duties</p> <p>a) General Internal Medicine: Working on ward 34 getting hands on experience of unselected acute and chronic illness in general medicine patients allowing development and progress of competencies including clinical skills, history, examination and diagnosis, decision making , investigation and treatment coordination, team working, increasing responsibility under clinical supervision, and discharge planning.</p> <p>b) Specialist: Working on ward 34 with management and exposure of acute diabetic problems including emergencies of diabetic ketoacidosis, hyperosmolar hyperglycaemic state and active diabetic foot disease. Experience of endocrine investigations and their interpretation. Option of attending outpatient speciality clinics as a supernumerary doctor to gain exposure of non acute diabetes and endocrinology.</p> <p>c) Acute medicine: Scheduled on call experience when off ward 34 being supervised by medical consultant and team on call.</p> <p>2.
