<p>The rota is quite complicated due to the number of areas to be covered. There is rotation between weeks on the in-patient wards, weeks in the children's emergency department (CED) and weeks covering daycase and performing baby checks. There are also "extra" weeks for taking annual leave or attending clinics for learning purposes. The rota is EWTD compliant and new contract compliant. On-call commitments include covering in-patient or CED areas until 1.30am, afterwards covering both areas with support from a paediatric middle grade doctor until 9am. There is consultant presence in the hospital until 11pm every evening. There is great opportunities for learning communication skills with different age ranges of children and families, and develop a variety of technical skills with children and young people.</p>
