Trainees will have exposure to OMFS/Orthodontic clinics multi-disciplinary meetings. The trainee will be exposed to full complement of general dentistry with supervision.

Description of training post	 This training year is very highly recommended for any trainee who wants to acquire good training in OMFS with lots of hand-on exposure to the full complements of Oral surgery procedures under LA and GA. This affords the trainee confidence and skills to practice as a GDP with special interest in surgical procedures. We have about 11 MOS sessions each week and 4 GA lists weekly. We are one of the few units that offer IV sedation experience, and we encourage our trainees to acquire

		 certificate in SAAD course or any other Conscious sedation training. We have designated parallel Casualty, dental assessment, and MOS clinics that the trainees run with seniors available to supervise them. Trainees have exposure to Orthognathic/Orthodontic sessions. We have protected teaching sessions every Friday and monthly audit meetings.

Pattern of working including any on-call commitment	 The trainees are supervised by consultants or SAS doctors during their training except the emergency clinics, dental assessment clinics which they get to run 2-3 times per week. There are 11 MOS clinics per week which they attend with a senior clinician to supervise. Level of supervision depends on trainee experience and skills. Each trainee gets one portfolio/admin session per week. Weekly Friday PM teaching session, monthly audit session and average of one GA session per week. There is on call commitment of on weekday per week and one weekend in 5 per training. The on call is always done with a senior SAS doctor to supervise the trainee. The DCT on-call ends at 10pm each day hence no overnight duty. There is emergency AM clinics over the weekend run by the DCT and SAS. The intensity of the on call is moderate. You have time off before and after weekend on call.
13.	Educational programme summary	 We have DCT teaching sessions every Friday afternoon which is protected learning time. We encourage trainees to register for postgraduate Dental Sedation Courses.
